Brief Summary of Job: Responsible for various types of weld preparation, welding and weld finishing operations to manufacture product to customer drawings, specifications, or other forms of instruction.

**Essential Duties and Responsibilities:**

- Proficient in assigned welding techniques.
- Interpretation of mechanical drawings, including weld requirement symbiology.
- Knowledge of wire and filler materials applications for various steel alloys, aluminum, and some exotic materials.
- Working knowledge of fixture and weld set up parameters (amps, volts, etc.)
- Conventional and precision measuring instruments.
- Process inspection, certification, and documentation.
- Welding equipment maintenance.
- Finish grinding applications using manual and power tools.
- Operates equipment and miscellaneous hand tools specific to assigned tasks safely.
- Responsible to detect and report defective materials or questionable conditions to the supervisor and/or appropriate personnel.
- Maintains work area and equipment in a clean and orderly manner.
- Follows defined safety regulations.
- Assist with prescribed preventative maintenance on machines as required.
- Communicates with co-workers, management, customers, and others in a courteous and professional manner.
- Conforms with and abides by all regulations, policies, work procedures, and instructions
- Other duties as assigned to meet business needs.

**Qualifications and Requirements:**

- High School diploma or its equivalent.
- One year experience in various forms of welding and cutting torch experience.
- Welding Certification
- Ability to operate forklift and crane
- Familiar with basic hand held measuring tools.
- Able to perform basic set-ups of equipment and tools required by position.
- Possess a general understanding of material grades and classifications.
- Familiar with quality system awareness.

**Physical Requirements:**

- Continually handles objects weighing up to 20 lbs and occasionally objects weighing up to 50 lbs.
- While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to use hands to finger, handle, or feel; reach with hands and arms; and talk or hear. The employee frequently is required to sit, stand; walk; and stoop, kneel or crouch.
- Occasionally required to sit and climb or balance, lift and/or move up to 20 pounds.
- Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, distance vision, color vision, peripheral vision, depth perception, and ability to adjust focus.

**Working Environment:**

- Work is performed in a production environment with temperature exposures that are impacted by seasonal weather conditions, due to limited heat sources and no air-conditioning.
- Regularly exposed to dust, odors, oil, fumes and noise.
- Mandatory requirement to wear appropriate PPE (personal, protective equipment) as defined by task and/or work area that can include all of some of the following: safety glasses, steel toed safety shoes, gloves, ear plugs, face mask, welder’s mask and any other proper clothing as required.
